Reverend Louisette Florexile

Rev. Louisette Florexile is an incredible woman who has dedicated her life to serving God and helping others. She is a youth pastor at Open Eye Church in NYC and also the founding pastor of Nazareth Church in Haiti. Louisette has always been passionate about spreading love and hope to those she meets.

After graduating and becoming ordained, she went on her first missionary trip to Haiti in 2010. It was here that she found her true calling in serving others. Following the devastating earthquake that struck the country, Louisette served the people in any way she could - cleaning, bathing, feeding, praying, and counseling those who were affected. She even traveled to different areas to ensure that everyone who needed help was served. By the time she was ready to leave, she had eight children who called her "mom."

Determined to help these children, Louisette used her voice and talent as a singer to raise funds for their care. She returned to Haiti after three months and rented a home with six bedrooms, hiring one staff member. Today, thanks to her unwavering determination and faith, *Now for Christ Orphanage*, is a completely transformed place. It is now fully staffed with dedicated caregivers who provide love, care, and support to the children. The once-empty bedrooms are now filled with beds and warm blankets, and every corner of the home is brimming with love and laughter. The children who once had to go without meals now have three nutritious meals a day, and they are able to attend school and receive an education. Rev. Louisette's vision has come to life, and she continues to work tirelessly to improve the lives of these children and give them a chance at a brighter future.

In addition to her work with the orphanage, Rev. Louisette is the President of Children for Change International. This non-profit organization supports children who have been victims of bullying and hate crimes in New York. She also serves on the Board of Directors of the God Squad. She is a true inspiration and a beacon of hope for everyone who knows her.
